Cat Oral Buprenorphine Information Sheet

- Buprenorphine (0.6 mg/ml) is an opioid pain medication that can be absorbed in cats through the mucous membranes/gums.
- Do not allow your cat to eat or drink water 30 minutes before or after receiving this medication to allow good absorption. Eating or drinking will change the pH of the mouth causing decreased absorption.
- This medication is usually given every 8-12 hours for pain.
- Never give more than the amount prescribed which for most cases will be 0.05 ml-0.1 ml every 8-12 hours. You can give less if your pet appears too drugged while on the medication.
- Place the prescribed amount into the cheek pouch.
- If you received a needle on your syringe it was only to help draw the medication out of the tube. **DO NOT INJECT YOUR PET.**
